Candidate must be admitted to practice in New York for at least four (4) years with courtroom experience and a strong background in municipal law.

Qualifications:

- Currently practicing law in New York State.
- Admitted to practice law in New York State for at least 4 years.
- Strong background and experience in municipal law.
- Familiar with NYS Penal Code, Vehicle & Traffic Laws, Criminal Procedure Act, Rules of Evidence, and the Village of Lancaster Code
- Experience in courtrooms and appropriate courtroom behavior.
- Experience practicing in the justice courts.
- Ability to defuse conflicts and hostile litigants in the courtroom.
- Close ties to the local community.
- Attend Zoning Board meetings on the 1st Thursday of each month.
- Attend Planning Commission meetings on the 3rd Thursday of each month.
- Attend Village Board meetings, work sessions, and committee meetings as needed in the absence of the Village Attorney.
- Coordinate and communicate with the Village Board and Village Attorney.
- Able to provide prompt service to the village when requested.
- Work schedule shall be based on tasks requested by the village.
