

Village of Lancaster Local Law _____ of the year 2022

A Local Law to delete redundant tree regulations from Chapter 297 of the
Village Code of the Village of Lancaster

Whereas the Village Board of the Village of Lancaster wishes to amend Chapter 297
“Streets and Sidewalks” of the Village Code to eliminate language redundant to §§310-
11 and 310-15 of Chapter 310 “Trees”;

Now;

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Lancaster, New York as follows:

1) § 297-9. “Injury to trees” of Chapter 297 “Street and Sidewalks” of the Village Code
shall be deleted in its entirety.

2) To accommodate the deletion of § 297-9. “Injury to trees” from Chapter 297, §297-10
“Penalties for offenses” shall be renumbered as §297-9

3) This local law shall become effective the 20th day following its enactment.
