

**VILLAGE OF LANCASTER
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2020**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE; That the Village of Lancaster Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing at 7:15 p.m. on Monday, September 14, 2020 in the Council Chambers, 2nd floor of the Lancaster Municipal Building, 5423 Broadway, Lancaster, New York to consider a local law to amend Chapter 225 “Parks” of the Code of the Village of Lancaster, New York.

If adopted, the proposed local law would amend Chapter 225 to identify village parks by name, to establish the hours the parks are open, to provide that the hours the parks are open are to be posted by the Village Superintendent of Public Works, to authorize the Village Mayor, the Village Superintendent of Public Works, and the Town of Lancaster Chief of Police to close any park for a period not exceeding 24 hours whenever, in his or her opinion, such closing is necessary to preserve the peace, safety, and security of the park, and to provide for enforcement of the “Parks” chapter by the Village of Lancaster Code Enforcement Officer and the Town of Lancaster Police Department.

At said hearing all persons so desiring shall have the opportunity to be heard.

As a consequence of COVID-19 public gathering restrictions, those wishing to be heard must participate via zoom meeting as the building will be closed to the public. To schedule their participation, any persons wishing to be heard should call the office of the Village Clerk, (716) 683-2105, during office hours not later than 3:00 P.M. on September 14th.
